**ALL TRAILERS MUST ENTER THE FAIRGROUNDS THROUGH THE SOUTH GATE.**

All animals must be properly cleaned and presented for the show or will be dismissed by the Show Committee.

## General Rules and Regulations

- No false hair or twining
- **Entry Fee must be processed by 6/10**
- All Committee Decisions are final
- Entry Fees are Non-Refundable
- Entries are confirmed once received
- **No child is permitted to stay overnight at the fairgrounds without individual's parent staying – must be prearranged.**
- It is the intent of this show for children to show their own animals. All exhibitors must be present on the fairgrounds during the show in order for the animal to be shown. Pre-arranged substitutions may be allowed by the superintendent.
- Proper attire must be worn during all shows. Optional Show shirt available for purchase or your own collar shirt, boots, and no soft shoes allowed in showing.
- Animals must arrive at time stated – NO LATE ARRIVALS.
- Exhibitors are not limited to numbers of animals. May only win 2 premiums per class.
- Full name ownership is required on all registration paperwork; no initials will be accepted.
- No animals released until conclusion of show on Sunday, June 23. Stalls must be cleaned and checked by superintendent before leaving. Comments cards to be turned in to superintendent at that time.
- Age of Participants – 8yrs by 1 Jan 24 – 21 yrs as of 1 Jan 24
- Food available for purchase on premises.
- A copy of all registration papers must accompany all entry forms.

- Pens must be cleaned daily by 8:00 am and rebedded.
- All blankets must be removed from animals prior to check-in.
- All trailers must enter the fairgrounds through the South Gate.
- **All animals must have CLEAN premises tag. ([www.mda.state.md.us](http://www.mda.state.md.us))**
- **A minimum of 5 entries are required for each species, in order for a show to be conducted (i.e. 5 Dairy Cows must be registered to hold a Dairy Cow show)**
- Straw, Sawdust or Shavings Bedding ONLY
- Bring own bedding and clean up own bedding
- Must meet Maryland Animal Health Regulations
- Committee not responsible for accidents
- Once space constraints are met, entries are cut off

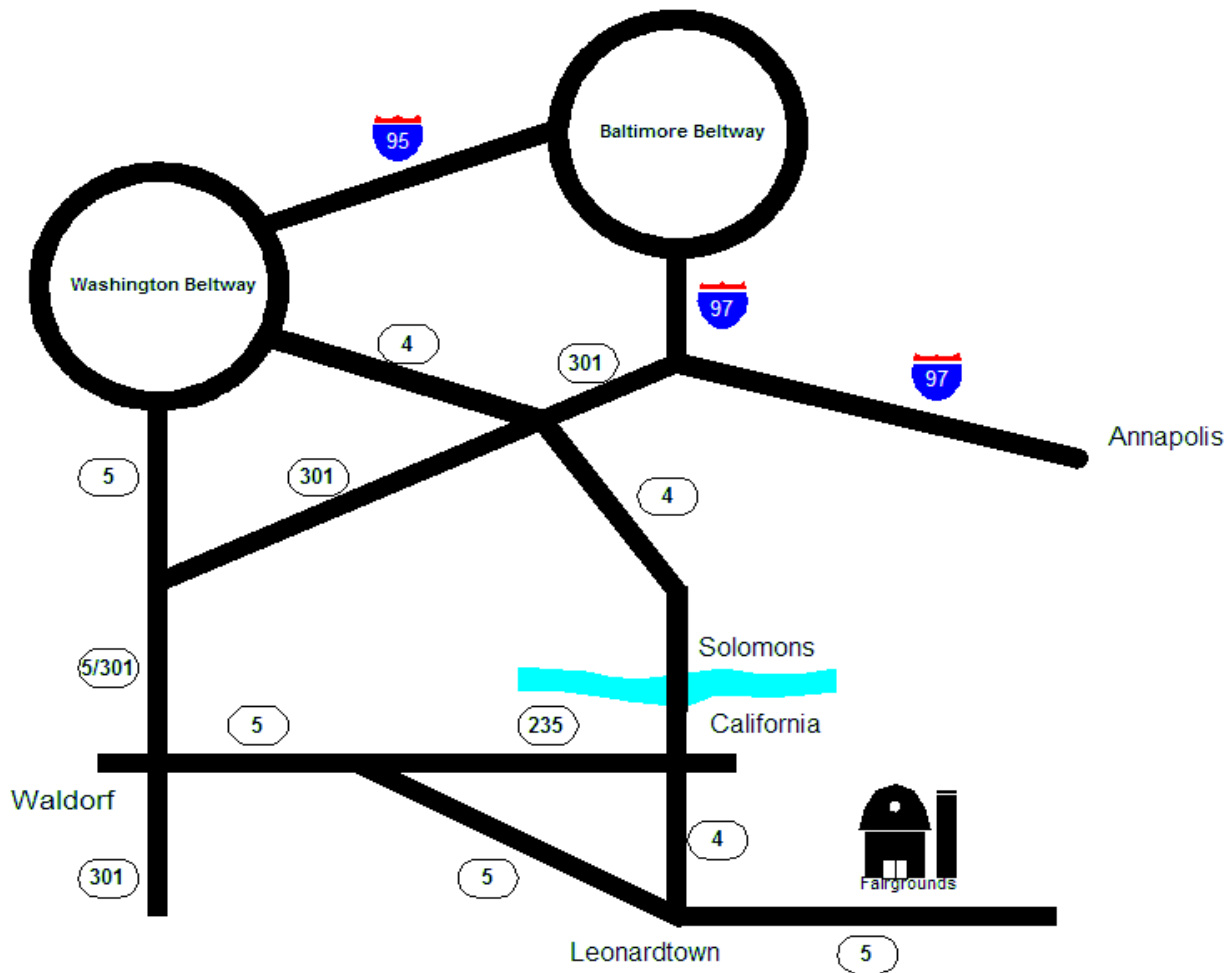
Entry Fees: Beef: \$25 per entry/Swine, Sheep, Dairy Cows and Goats: \$15 per entry, Rabbit Breed Class \$5 per entry, Rabbit Market Pen \$6 per entry, Rabbit Pet Class \$5 per entry, Cavy \$4 per entry

**All 2024 entries, including PeeWee/Novice Showmanship, will be submitted online.**

## From Waldorf, MD

Take Route 5 South. Route 5 eventually merges into Route 235. Continue straight onto Route 235 until you intersect with Route 4 in California, MD. Turn right on Route 4 and continue until 4 ends at Route 5. Turn left onto Route 5. The fairgrounds are on the left approximately one mile beyond the turn. Go through the light at Fairgrounds Road and the first driveway on the left pass the Fast Stop is the entrance to the South Gate.

## From Calvert County, MD

Take Route 4 South. Continue over the bridge at Solomons into St. Mary's County. Continue through the intersection of Routes 4 and 235 until 4 ends at Route 5. Turn left onto Route 5. The fairgrounds are on the left approximately one mile beyond the turn. Go through the light at Fairgrounds Road and the first driveway on the left pass the Fast Stop is the entrance to the South Gate.
